Night work continues on the project.

Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Campground (Extension) Primary Focus:

Between Lake Creek Bridge and Spring Bar Campground the following work is anticipated to take place:

- Complete Riprap embankment, building fill and utility conduit/vault installation east of Lake Creek Bridge
- Install pipe culverts in Riprap embankments
- Mechanically Stabilized Earth wall excavation east of Lake Creek Bridge
- Possible installation of irrigation culverts west of Hot Springs Bridge
