Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Campground (Extension) Primary Focus:

- Continue to excavate and possibly begin installation of final mechanically stabilized earth wall east of Lake Creek Bridge
- Blowing out new utility conduits between Lake Creek Bridge and Hot Springs Bridge
- Material screening and possibly installation of pipe culverts
