Salmon River Road (5), Lake Creek Bridge to Spring Bar Campground (Extension) Primary Focus:

- Continue with excavation of rock slope west of Spring Bar Campground
- Anticipate utility vault and conduit installation adjacent to Hot Springs Bridge
- Communication crews will be on the project to pull underground cable through conduit in the roadway
