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BEAVER CREEK ROAD NEWSLETTER

In partnership with the US Forest Service and the Crook County Road Department, the Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration will be making substantial improvements to Beaver Creek Road. Located near Paulina, Oregon, the improvements will begin at the intersection of the Paulina/Suplee Highway and Beaver Creek Road and will end approximately 300 feet past the Ochoco National Forest Boundary. Construction operations will be carried out by Tidewater Contractors, Inc.

Significant traffic delays during construction are not anticipated for the following week. A maximum delay of 30 minutes is allowed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and between 5:00 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Construction Progress

Tidewater Contractors, Inc will continue surveying locations for culvert installation beginning at the north end of the project and moving south. While the survey crew moves through the project, the grade crew will continue stockpiling the plastic culvert pipe at designated locations.
