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BEAVER CREEK ROAD NEWSLETTER

In partnership with the US Forest Service and the Crook County Road Department, the Western Federal Lands Highway Division of the Federal Highway Administration will be making substantial improvements to Beaver Creek Road. Located near Paulina, Oregon, the improvements will begin at the intersection of the Paulina/Suplee Highway and Beaver Creek Road and will end approximately 300 feet past the Ochoco National Forest Boundary. Construction operations will be carried out by Tidewater Contractors, Inc.

Significant traffic delays during construction are not anticipated for the following week. A maximum delay of 30 minutes is allowed between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and between 5:00 p.m. and 6 a.m.

Construction Progress

Tidewater Contractors, Inc continued surveying locations for culvert installation. Tidewater also began surveying right-of-way locations in preparation for installation of right-of-way fencing.

Construction Activities for the week ending August 14, 2009

The contractor anticipates relocating fencing on the south end of the project and installing fence on the North end of the project. The contractor may also proceed with surveying on Beaver Creek Road.
