

Highway 35



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This week Tapani had construction sites on both sides of White River. On the east side as seen in the photo on the right they were working on culvert extensions. A 10" pump noted as the orange unit was intercepting water prior to the site and diverting to another cross pipe nearby thus placing stream flow back into its natural stream bed. Another smaller pump was down in the hole near where the excavator is digging removing ground water. Visual observations and turbidity instrument readings by both Tapani's Water Quality Supervisor and Federal Highway's inspector have shown water quality is being maintained and well within defined limits.



The photo below was taken on July 21st west of White River to show clearing is progressing well. The stockpiled logs are being used for stream enhancement by the USFS. The far excavator in this photo was working to install a temporary culvert.



Out at Tamarack Quarry near Trillium Camp Ground the contractor has completed most of their required safety improvement and is now moving material from the upper quarry level to the lower level and building a stockpile for future crushing.

Next week travelers will encounter traffic control on Highway 35 in the form of brief stops for trucks crossing the road in the White River area.

Quarry operations are being minimized awaiting resolution of a production question. Even with minimized operations the quarry will remain closed to public access.
